we will have a special celebration in April but he will have to run an extra .2 to get his medal! Remember the winter starting time is 5:30 PM each Wednesday in Highland Park.

In the women's race Bethany and Brittany Neeley took a break from their undefeated Greentown Comets basketball schedule to finish first and third with times of 20:05 and 20:18 with all -time great KHS track star, Byron Bundrent, sandwiched inbetween. It was great to see Byron easing back into racing as he is now a Grandmaster at age 50. Among the walkers Vince Lorenz lowered his course record by one tick with a time of 27:19.

We had an incredibly strong finish to 2010 and I'm excited to see what the new year will bring. As we end the year the Club Kokomo's family of runners and walkers has grown to

almost 500 strong. I'm sure each of you have some special goals for yourselves, family members and loved ones. It is my hope that Club Kokomo can help each of you reach goals in every aspect of your life through our events, programs and the friendships that are formed. I encourage vou to get involved, be an encouragement to others and volunteer when the spirit moves you. I have been blessed beyond measure and you can be too. 


