There is race day registration from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

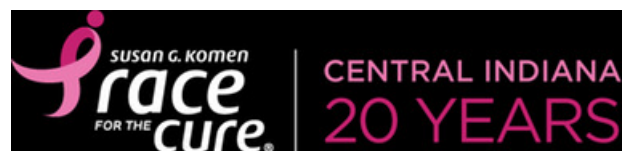
Participants in the Pink Parade begin lining up at 7:15 a.m.

My body is still feeling that last mile into the wind and up the hill! Many club members volunteered and got the a cool Costa volunteer sweatshirt. Special thanks to CK member and longtime Costa Race Director, Terry Townsend and wife Robin for having the passion and logistical expertise to keep this race alive and well. In 42 years Costa has evolved from a country run to a tour of one of the fastest growing and best planned communi-

ties in the US. It is really cool that Northview Church partners with the local running community for this signature race. You may or may not have noticed but there is also a state of the art cross country course on the church grounds, a course so well designed that Carmel High School holds X/C meets and the conference championship there. Ray and I share a dream of a similar running facility in Kokomo not to mention an indoor track! It could happen but not without a dream and a well thought out vision.

Don't count the dreamer's out! In 1999 Indiana Trails Fund purchased and railbanked thirty-five miles of abandoned rail corridor from Norfolk Southern Railroad for \$50,000. Thirty-four of those miles are now paved. This year the bridge over the Wabash will be finished, the trail will be paved into Peru, and another acquisition will extend the trail to Downtown Rochester. In Howard County

plans are falling into place that will cost effectively bring the trail to Kokomo city limits by 2013. What was once a vision of a few is now a vision shared by many who desire a better quality of life and a more livable community.

April is the official month of Earth Day so stay tuned for upcoming river, trail and roadside cleanup opportunities. If you are spending spring break at home and would like to help on a week-day let me know. March 14, 2011

 2. Haynes-Apperson-Rebekah will be applying for the permit with the traffic commission this week. She has the current insurance form to show them. She outlined her needs for the race and would be contacting those who assisted last year.
 3. Relay for Life half marathon on May 21. Charlie Skoog read letter about traffic concerns. Race organizers want to use our big clock.  7. Relay for Life-Team Captain needed. Patty Weitzel volunteered to assume this duty.
 8. Brief Treasurer's report by Mark Shorter
 9. New Business- Mark Shorter moved and Patty Weitzel and Robin Cole seconded, " To make Walker age groups for year-end points awards that same as Runner age groups and be effective for 2011." Passed by a vote of 10 to 3. This is the first reading of a CKRR Constitution change. It must pass at the next meeting unchanged to take effect.
 10. Charlie Skoog announced that the Wednesday night Miracle Mile time will change to 6PM beginning March 16, 2011.
