run along the bay. The terrain offered some rolling hills but the worst was the last uphill mile. That wasn't very nice. We walked most of that mile. We weren't in a hurry to finish and we wanted to save energy for marathon #2 on the following Sunday.

Our legs were dead, and I wanted to soothe mine with the frigid Pacific Ocean. Everyone thought I was crazy, but they humored me and took me to a beach down the road. It felt great! It was freezing, but it felt great!

We got our showers at a local high school and headed back to Eugene to enjoy the week with my mom, sisters, and their families.

One of the things we did in Eugene, "the running capital of the world," was visit the park where Steve Prefontaine ran. We located the trails which were wood chip trails, and found our way over to Haworth field to get pictures of the famous track! It was quite an experience as they were preparing for the Olympic trials and the gates were open. What a premier facility!

Friday we flew out of Portland and into Spokane to prepare for our second marathon. What a beautiful drive from Spokane to Winthrop, Washington. It was about a three and a half hour drive into the wild west!

The town of Winthrop is a charming town with a western town image. All of the buildings have an old west flavor. They even had wood plank sidewalks. pick up and pasta dinner were Saturday night. We went to bed and were up for an early bus ride at 6:15 am to the journey up the mountain.

Needless to say, he was discouraged and walked most of the last of it. Ray finished in 5:46 and I finished in 5:52. There were only 89 finishers in this small, but awesome marathon. 
